SCROLL BOX INSTRUCTIONS

Print the scroll box wrap pattern onto the back of the selected wrap paper

Carefully cut out the scroll box wrap pattern along the solid lines & set aside

Print the scroll box interior piece pattern onto regular print paper

Tape the interior piece pattern onto a piece of poster board.

Carefully cut out the scroll box interior pieces from the poster board – cut right on the solid lines. Cut out the square hole in both square pieces.

Mark the asterisk on the poster board piece

Using the glue stick, carefully glue the poster board pieces onto the designated areas of the scroll box wrap. The long areas are all the same except for the asterisk area, make certain the marked poster board piece goes in the asterisk area. Ensure the square pieces are oriented for a best fit (they apparently aren't exactly square). Use the bone folder to burnish and secure the glue seam.

Glue & wrap the long flaps back onto the interior pieces. Use the bone folder to burnish secure the glue seam.

Glue & wrap the flaps back onto the square interior pieces, use the bone folder to burnish and secure the glue seam. There should be six end tabs that are **not glued** at this point.

Cut the two bamboo skewers to length (7 1/8")

Use one of the pointed cut off pieces to pierce through the center holes in the square interior pieces

Make a line 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " in from each end of the scroll paper

Use a bone folder to fold the scroll paper around a cut bamboo skewer and match the drawn line. Form the paper so that the bamboo skewer lies on the written side of the scroll. Remove the skewer, apply stick glue, re-insert the skewer and use the bone folder to secure the glue. Ensure that the end of the paper is matched to the drawn line and the skewer is centered on the paper so there is an equal length on either side of the paper. Do this on both ends of the scroll paper.

Make the folds between the sections of the scroll box and on the end tabs

Lay the scroll paper on the scroll box so that the inside end of the scroll is laying on the scroll box section with the squares. The scroll should extend to the left and two sections of the scroll box should extend to the right of the scroll paper.

Fold up one of the pierced squares and insert a skewer end through the pierced hole. Fold up the other pierced square and do the same on the other side.

Wrap the two scroll box sections around so that the rectangular tabs are aligned with the square pieces. Apply stick glue to one of the rectangular tabs and glue it to the outside of the square piece – making certain everything is square and aligned.

Pressing from the inside with your fingers, use the bone folder on the outside to burnish the glue seam. Repeat on the other side – pushing from the inside won't be possible but burnish as possible without putting too much pressure on the box.

Apply stick glue to the trapezoidal tabs on each side and glue them to the square ends, burnishing as possible

Slip a wooden bead over each end of the inside bamboo skewer (keeping the bead aligned with the end of the skewer) and apply a drop of white PVA glue into each end. Allow to dry.

Slip a colored bead over each end of the outside skewer (should be a tight fit – scrape a little off the skewer with an x-acto knife if it wont fit).

After the glued beads are dry hold the scroll box with the paper pointing away from you and turn the right bead in a clockwise direction to roll the scroll into the box.
